## Requirements

Section Leaders/Soloists are called upon to:

- Perform, convincingly and authentically, a wide range of diverse musical styles; should possess great
  musical flexibility, along with overall musical competency, excellent sight reading, and a command of
  commonly performed languages.
- Serve as positive examples within their respective sections, offering both musical and personal leadership, and setting a tone of collegiality and professionalism.
- Within reason, be prepared (notes, rhythms, and language learned) prior to all rehearsals and performances.
- Attend and participate in all Thursday evening and Sunday morning/afternoon rehearsals (except as mutually agreed in advance)
- Sing for the 10:00 a.m. Service every Sunday (8:45-9:45 rehearsal), Thursday evening rehearsals (7:00 to 9:30 pm, September through May), and after-church rehearsals (11:30-1:00 pm, an average of three Sundays a month, September to May)
- Sing frequent solos and small ensembles in worship as called upon
- Sing for special Liturgies as called upon, including Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and additional Easter Day services
